

Increase in British Judo Grading Fees as of 1st October 2013

I am writing to inform you of increases to British Judo's grading fees effective 1st October 2013.

Grading fees are split between a number of items:

- The administration of gradings by the British Judo membership team
- Personalised gradings certificates
- Postage and fulfilment costs
- Grading rebate paid directly to British Judo areas

British Judo's Mon and Kyu grade fees have not been increased for two years with other grading fees not receiving increases in over five years, during which time there have been significant increases in administration, print, postage and fulfilment costs.

Therefore, the following increases will be applied:
